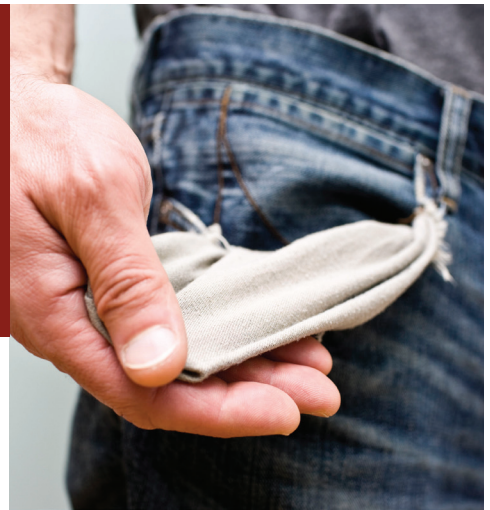
UNEMPLOYMENT BRIDGE PROGRAM

The Kentucky Unemployment Bridge Program (UBP) can help eligible homeowners make their mortgage payments.

- To be eligible, the homeowner must have experienced a job loss or reduction in income due to changing economic conditions, through no fault of their own, or a long-term/permanent disability, and must demonstrate a need for assistance.
- The employment-related event must have occurred within the previous three-year period. The qualifying disability must have occurred after the first mortgage note date.
- The maximum amount of assistance is \$15,000 or 12 months, whichever occurs first.

Other qualifications apply. There is no charge for this service.
